Laptops - Goal \$2,500

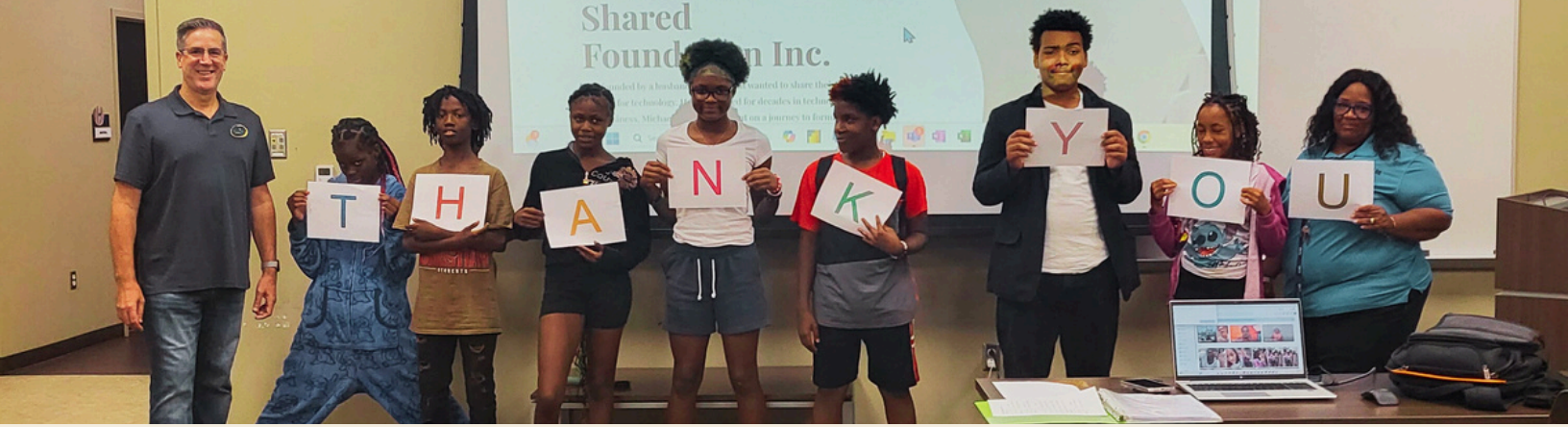
- Monetary donations to purchase laptops for trainers to use in classes.
